ASSEMBLY AT AROMAS SCHOOL PARKING LOT ~ 1PM

Participation rules:

- Drivers must be over the age of 16 and have a valid driver's license to operate motorized vehicles in the parade. This includes but is not limited to any kind of car, truck, tractor & other farm machinery, motorcycles, minibikes, go carts, golf carts, mopeds, or motorized scooters.
- All animals must be leashed, bridled or otherwise restrained and under control at all times. Parade management may remove your animal from the Parade if there are any doubts about your ability to control your animal. Under no circumstances may anyone ride on an animal in the parade unless they have provided a certificate of liability insurance with an endorsement in favor of the Fraternal Order of Eagles #72 before August 6, 2022.
- Current incumbents of elective offices are welcome and encouraged to participate. However, declared candidates for elective office, including incumbents seeking re-election, must pay the commercial entry fee. Entry fees also apply to those groups displaying messages regarding issues coming to a vote in a future election.
- Candy & other items MAY NOT be thrown into the crowd from any Parade entry. This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced. Violators may be forbidden from future parades.
- Participants may stop and perform in front of the MC station (Carpenteria and Blohm) for 30 seconds only. Please move promptly when waved on.
- Upon check-in participants will be assigned a place in the parade line up and are to remain in that place until the parade is over. Participants who leave parade line up may not be allowed to re-enter the parade.
- Assembly begins in the Aromas School parking lot at 1:00PM. BE ON TIME. Entry for Parade vehicles/floats will be at the Carpenteria & Aromas Rd blockade (across from railroad tracks).
